NO Meeting at the church in July.

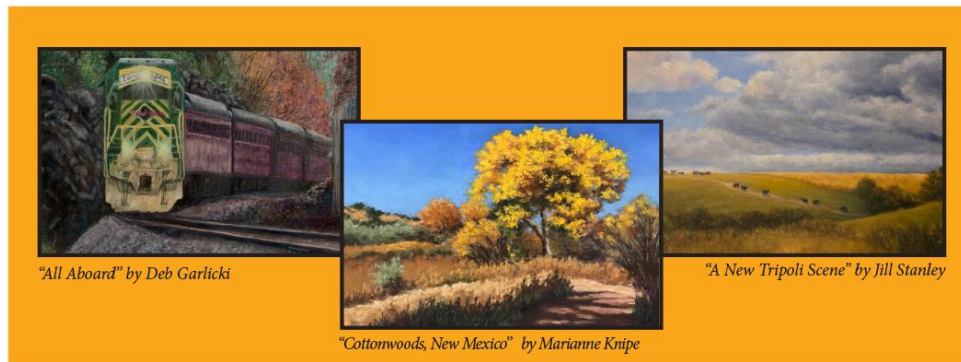
Join other PAL members at our receptions at Stony Run Winery and Blue Mountain Winery.

Switch day is Tuesday July 1st from 10 to noon.

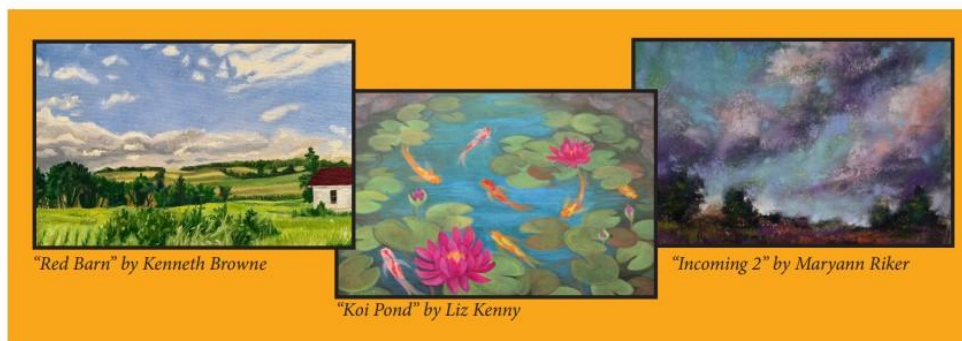
